GLOCESTER CODE OF ORDINANCE - PROPOSED ZONING AMENDMENT

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws 45-24-53, and in accordance with the Gloucester Home Rule Charter, that a Public Hearing will be held in the Town Council Chambers of the Gloucester Town Hall, 1145 Putnam Pike, Gloucester, RI on Thursday, April 2, 2020 at 7:30 PM. The purpose of this meeting is to consider a proposed amendment to the Code of Ordinance as summarized below:

Proposed Ordinance:

Chapter 350 Zoning: Article IX Section 350-67 through 350-80 inclusive
Historic District Zoning

The proposed amendment includes changes to the permitting and procedures for improvements to or demolition of all structures within the Historic District

The proposed amendments are available for public inspection and reproduction in the office of the Gloucester Town Clerk, Monday through Friday, 8:00AM to 4:30PM and on the Town's website, <http://www.glocesterri.org>.

The proposed amendment may be altered prior to the close of the Public Hearing without further advertising, as a result of further study or because of the views expressed at the Public Hearing.
