

# **Town of Lincoln Public Schools Invitation to Bid Student Transportation Services**

Lincoln Public Schools will receive sealed proposals for the furnishing of Student Transportation Services until January 26, 2021 at 2:00 p.m., at which time they will be publicly virtually opened and read in the Lincoln School Department Administrative Conference Room, 1624 Lonsdale Avenue, Lincoln, RI 02865.

The proposal requires the furnishing of scheduled Student Transportation for all designated school children of the Lincoln Public Schools to include "Regular Transportation" and "Athletic and Extra Curricular Activities" for an initial period of three years, beginning July 1, 2021 plus two additional option years. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish all service necessary and required, but not necessarily limited to the following in general: Transportation Equipment, Maintenance of Equipment, Operation, Drivers, Monitors/Bus Aides, Supervision, Inspection, Registration, Licensing, Insurance and conformance to all applicable laws, rules, and regulations of the State of Rhode Island, Department of Motor Vehicles, Department of Public Utilities, State Police, Town of Lincoln and the Lincoln Public Schools.

A virtual pre-bid conference will be held for all interested bidders, on January 13, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. at the Lincoln School Department Administrative Conference Room, 1624 Lonsdale Avenue, Lincoln, RI 02865.
