The Town of Foster Zoning Board of Review will hold a Public Hearing on May 12, 2021 at 7PM remotely via Zoom.us for a property located on 12 Snagwood Road, being Plat 13 Lot 36 in an Agricultural/Residential AR district on 11.33 acres. The Applicant and Owner, Randall Bagwell, seeks a Special Use Permit for a Day Camp, Use #11 “Public or Semi-Public Uses”, Section 38-191 the Town of Foster Zoning Ordinances. The applicant proposes to create temporary shelter for veterans with the addition of a one-unit building to be located on the premise.

All interested persons are invited to attend the Public Hearing and be heard. Modifications to the proposal may occur as a result of the comments received during the hearing or as a result of further study. The application can be reviewed at Town Hall at 181 Howard Hill Road in the Planning Department during normal business hours by appointment only.
